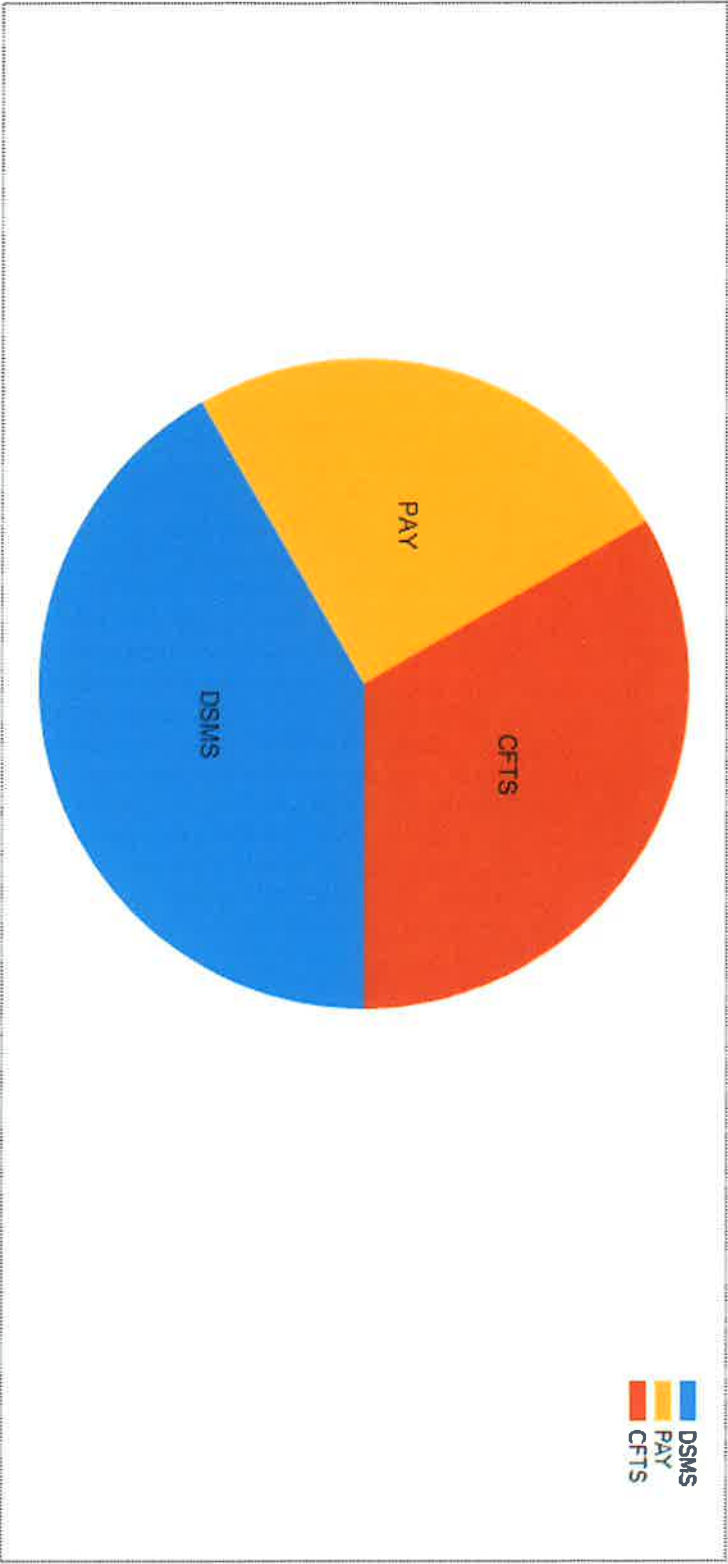

. President's Report

July 10, 2024

1. Old Mexia Road Project: The road is closed for construction and signs have been posted notifying traffic of the closure as well as detour signs. I have sent a letter to all property owners along the road explaining the construction timeline and notifying them of the detour. I also sent a letter and/or spoke to the County Commissioner Andy Bonner, Sheriff's office, police department, fire department and the EMS regarding the matter. The detour is through the North industrial park along Industrial Park Drive and Cottonwood Creek Drive.
2. Old Mexia Road Project: The contractor has cleared a portion of our Bournias Tract and installed a culvert with access on Old Mexia Road to stage his equipment and provide a waste area for trees and other debris.
3. Old Mexia Road Project: The old culvert at Cottonwood Creek has been removed and the channel has been bedded with rock. On July 15th the contractor will be on site to do some prep work and on Tuesday, July 16th, the concrete box culverts will arrive and be put into place.
4. Old Mexia Road Project: Change Order #2 consisting of reroute of the 6" water line and installation of the pipe casing with valves has been completed.
5. Old Mexia Road Project: The EDA sign has been posted on our property at the corner of Old Mexia Road and Cottonwood Creek Drive. The sign is required by the EDA and the purpose of it is to notify the public that a portion of the funding for the Old Mexia Road project came from the Economic Development Administration funds.
6. One of our marketing partners, Day One Experts, has invited us to participate in a "Best of Texas Tour." The tour will bring delegates from Taiwan, Korea, Canada, and Japan, consisting of a mix of commercial brokers, business owners, and developers that would like to explore investment opportunities in Texas. The tour will stop in Fairfield on Saturday, October 5, 2024, from 11:30 to 1:00pm. Following arrival, we will be allowed to give a 30-minute lunch presentation and then photo opportunities at a location of our choice. Our cost will be \$1,350 sponsorship fee, along with lunch and any venue fee. There will be approximately twenty participants on the bus. The arrival location and departure will be Houston. Stops along the way will be Huntsville, Marshall, Kilgore, Melissa, Plano, Fort Worth and Fairfield. Our stop will be the last on their way back to Houston. We are in the planning process to make this a memorable stop. (Board members received a handout from Day One Experts)
7. Website Update: GSLI has sent me a link to the newly designed home page of our website and will be scheduling a call to discuss the copy development for the pages. The new site design will have vibrant pictures and there will be a big emphasis on success stories and our industrial park land.
8. Marketing Flyer Update: I am working on a marketing flyer that will highlight the estimated costs to build a 10K, 20K, 50K and 100K square foot building in the industrial park. The flyer will include an architect rendering of the building. (Board members received a handout from San Antonio as an example)
9. Next meeting is August 7, 2024.



FIRE CHIEF MONTHLY REPORT JULY 2024

Dear City Council and Mayor,

I hope this message finds you well. As part of our ongoing commitment to public safety, I am pleased to provide you with a report providing a snapshot of last month's high-level activities:

1. **STAFF:** As of August 1, our official headcount stands at 14. Currently 2 new prospects have approached the department; applications have been submitted and they are under review by the membership.
2. **APPARATUSES:**
 - Grass 86 upfit on pause due to start of peak wild/grass fire season. More to come after the season has passed, stay tuned.
 - Engine 82 - in the beginning stages of putting our RFQ's for battery charger wiring/install and compartment retrofitting for spare extrication tool(s).
3. **TOOLS / PPE:** Additional extrication tools have been identified and narrowed down to the specific ones that are fit for purpose for the department and that can co-mingle with the existing without disruption or added cost for retrofits.
4. **STATION:** Up fits
 - *Bay door project on-going; waiting for "ordered" parts as per OGD.*
 - *Gas Line and Bay Heaters: everything is complete pending final test of the gas reducer to the emergency generator.*
 - *Electrical Drops: quote request from J&H to review and add to proposed 2025 budget to get the building bay electrical in NEC/NFPA Code Compliance.*
5. **LOCAL SUPPORT:**
 - *4th of July Fireworks (July 5): 3 apparatuses staged for suppression and rescue support as needed*
 - *Received much needed water from local donations at Brookshire's (July 7).*
 - *Local Girl Scouts donated 4 cases of cookies (July 10).*
 - *Fuzzy Peach Festival (July 19 & 20): Set up bounce house on the square and had a member participate in the cupcake eating contest.*
 - *Hydrant flow test for Round Prairie FP Engineers designing the suppression system (July 24).*
6. **CALL VOLUME:** In July we recorded a total of 45 calls, averaging approximately 1.45 calls per day. The months' call volume exceeded July 2023's total by ~ 4.4%.

On behalf of myself and the entire Fire Department, we are committed to enhancing the efficiency and effectiveness of our city's and county's emergency response. Achieving this can only be done with your continued support and invaluable assistance.

We deeply appreciate your time, dedication, and vision for a safe and thriving city. As we look to the future, we see immense potential on the horizon, and together, we can achieve great things.
